GUIDELINES FOR PARTICIPANTS

Eligibility

Open to school children of classes 8-12 standard

Number of Participants

Team participation (max. 3-5 students per team)

Materials

Models must be made only from waste / discarded / recyclable items (plastic bottles, cans, cardboard, newspapers, old CDs, broken toys, e-waste, coconut shells, etc.). Minimal use of new materials like glue, tape, or chart paper is allowed only for support.

Size & Presentation

Models should be manageable in size (not larger than 2 ft x 2 ft).

Each participant/team must be ready to explain the idea (2-3 minutes).

Time Limit

Participants should bring the ready model from home.

On-the-spot finishing touches can be done within 30 minutes if needed.
